#### **COOKIE POLICY**

For simplicity, we refer to cookies and similar technologies as "cookies."

Through this cookie policy, we aim to inform you about the cookies we use on the website, the reasons for their use, and how you can delete or disable cookies.

#### 1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small text and number file that we store in your browser or on your computer's hard drive. This allows us to remember your preferences when using our website (e.g., language choice). Unless you have adjusted your browser settings to refuse cookies, our system will place cookies as soon as you visit our website. The cookies we use on this website are safe and intended to make your visit as pleasant as possible. We anonymize the data we collect via cookies as much as possible.

#### 2. TYPES OF COOKIES

Cookies may be classified based on their origin, purpose, and duration of storage.

- **First-party cookies:** are cookies that we manage ourselves. We use these, for example, to ensure that our website functions properly. This enhances the quality of our online services.
- Third-party cookies are cookies placed by a domain name other than that of our website. If you visit our website and a third party places a cookie through our website, this is a third-party cookie. Through a third-party cookie, certain data from your visit or use of our website can be sent to this third party. For cookies placed by third parties, we refer you to the statements these parties provide on their respective websites. Please note that we have no influence over the content of these statements or the content of the cookies from these third parties.

De first-en third-party cookies can be further divided into, among others:

- **Essential or strictly necessary cookies** are, as their name suggests, necessary to use a website, to provide certain functions you request, and to ensure secure identity verification.
- Functional cookies are cookies that ensure the website operates properly. They store information about your choices and preferences on our website (e.g., cookies for remembering log-in or registration, your language preference, items in your shopping cart). Functional cookies are logically first-party cookies.
- Non-functional cookies are cookies that may be placed for statistical, social, targeting, and commercial purposes. They are not related to the purely technical support of the website. Non-functional cookies can be first-party or third-party cookies.
  - Cookies for statistical purposes allow us to determine which pages of the website you visit, where your computer is located, etc. (Google Analytics, Google Tag Manager, Hotjar).
  - Cookies for social purposes enable the user to directly share the content of the visited website with others via social media (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube).

- Cookies for targeting purposes allow a profile to be built based on your browsing behavior so that the displayed advertisements are tailored to your interests (Facebook).
- Cookies for commercial purposes track how many and which advertisements have been shown to a user (Google Adwords and Bing ads).

Cookies can also be categorized according to their lifespan:

- **Permanent cookies:** These cookies remain on the user's device for the duration specified in the cookie. They are activated each time the user visits the website that placed this cookie (e.g., cookies placed by social media such as Facebook, Google Analytics, etc.). Most non-functional cookies are permanent cookies.
- Session cookies: These cookies allow us to simplify and link a user's actions during a browser session. A browser session begins when a user opens the browser window and ends when they close the browser window. Session cookies are temporarily placed. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted. Most functional cookies are session cookies.

# 3. WHAT TYPE OF COOKIES DO WE USE ON THIS WEBSITE?

Our website uses strictly necessary and functional cookies to distinguish your usage preferences from those of other users of our website, to facilitate easy navigation between different parts of our website, to identify you, etc. This helps us provide you with a better user experience when you visit our website and also allows us to optimize our website.

If you do not want websites to place cookies on your computer or wish to delete your cookies, you can change your cookie settings in your web browser.
